Hands-On Construction Workshop

Deer Haven Farms – Newberg, Oregon

May 16th – 20th, 2012

Expanded Workshop Description (21 enrollees max.)

This 4-day Workshop set in on a family owned farm just outside of Portland, Oregon and will focus on treehouse platform mechanics and treehouse construction. Learn how to build a functional platform that connects safely and securely to the tree. Participants will have the opportunity to learn through demonstrations and hands-on experience, helping to build a treehouse that will become the focal point of the workshop.

In addition, we will hold small group classes demonstrating rigging and climbing techniques to assist you in building your treehouse safely and efficiently. Here you will learn the configuration and use of simple, yet, ingeniously designed mechanisms strategically placed in the trees that allow you to hoist heavy loads into trees, an all-important technical skill that enables treehouse building without the use of heavy hydraulic equipment. You will also learn and practice the art of SRT (single rope technique for climbing) to allow you to safely ascend, perch, and descend your tree(s) while building.

Other small group sessions will acquaint you with the design and engineering process of single, two, and three-tree design applications. Along with other design considerations applicable to the design development process, become informed about tree attachment technology and how the weight of the treehouse can sit safely and securely within the tree's limbs by using the proper connection.

All this and more will be offered in a relaxed setting with small groups of participants rotating through various learning stations. The informational classes and hands-on demonstrations are scheduled the first day of the workshop. As participants gain familiarity, knowledge, and skill, we begin to put these assets to use in the form of platform and treehouse building. Construction commences the first day and continues throughout the workshop. We will eat meals together and have ample time for discussion and sharing.
